Your Resume

The most important document you will be presenting to your next prospective employer. It is imperative that ample thought, effort and attention to detail has been invested in building it. - Clean, concise, and spellchecked

Online Presence & Networking ... Does it really matter?

A survey conducted in 2020 of 1005 hiring decision-makers by the Harris poll found that **67%** of employers use social media to research potential job candidates.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, about **75-85%** of jobs are found through Networking.

54% of employers have eliminated candidates based on their social media content.

Top 3 reasons employers search social media profiles:

- **51%** to see if you fit the culture
- **45%** look for qualifications
- 44% look for creativity

The Non-Verbal Mistakes

- 67% Fail to make eye contact
- 47% show lack of company knowledge
- 38% don't smile during interview
- 33% have bad posture

First Impressions are Determined By

- 55% by the way you dress, act and walk through the door
- 38% by quality of voice, grammar and confidence
- 7% by the words you choose to say

In a survey of 2000 hiring Managers, **33%** claimed to know whether they would hire someone within **90 seconds!!!!!**
