Review application with MSOC staff liaison



Complete and submit application to MSOC



MSOC reviews application and conducts a Team Resource Visit



If approved and ready, community receives the Select Level designation and benefits

APPLICATION & PROGRAM COMPONENTS



Affirm local governmental support, including a new resolution



Have staff in place to manage the downtown organization or a commitment to hire such a position within three months



Have a Board and By-Laws—with an Inclusion Policy, Conflict Policy, Participation Policy, and Code of Conduct Policy



Establish a taskforce or committees reflective of the Main Street approach



Devise and outline economic strategies for the district with an outlook of two to three years and have a budget in place to meet the programmatic needs of the program



Vision, mission and workplans around economic strategies



Communication plan



Volunteer program



Ability to track and report statistics in key economic impact areas, including public and private investment, new businesses and jobs, and volunteer hours



Actively participate in MSOC Managers Meetings and Main Street America trainings, conferences and workshops
