

How to Watch, Attend and Address the Board During Standing Committee and Full Board Meetings

Per state recommendations, the Oakland County Board of Commissioners has returned to hosting standing committee and full Board meetings in-person and will no longer be meeting remotely. Those who wish to address the Board by participating in public comment during these meetings will have the opportunity to do so in-person. Individuals may also access the meetings live via YouTube.
